Thank you to everyone that was present for our second Street Closure Committee Meeting. I think we are off to a great start!

1. Stair Climb for Los Angeles: Approved

2. Fiestas Patrias: Deferred.

- We would like them to come back with a letter from Union Station giving their support since this will affect them. We would also like them to start outreach ASAP, not 30 days prior.

3. Ecuadorian Independence Celebration: Deferred to next meeting

- They need to come back with a list of residential buildings that they reached out to with actual names of people that signed off. Diana will be putting together a list of the residential properties affected by their street closures.

4. Grand Park's 4th of July

- They will be connecting with our BIDs to ensure as much of the community is involved as possible at this event!

5. Los Angeles Food and Wine: Approved

- We would like them to reach out to local parking lots and have that information accessible to everyone. Work with the BIDs and the Council Office to get the word out!

6. Nana's Cure: Approved with flying colors

7. Fashion District Farmer's Market

- They are not approved.

8. Bicycle Criterium Race: deferred

- List of residential properties will be provided for them to reach out to. Need to come back next meeting with the signed off addresses.
