



Who is Grand Park? Grand Park, with its majestic views extending from The Music Center to City Hall, provides Angelenos of all walks of life a place where they can come together to celebrate, reflect, and shape the future, in one central gathering place. Located in Downtown LA’s Bunker Hill neighborhood and activated 52 weeks a year by The Music Center with free events for all, Grand Park has become a hub for both large and small scale events. The park also hosts rentals, film shoots, and lease events.

What is Grand Park’s 4th of July Block Party? A free family friendly event, Grand Park’s 4th of July Block party invites all residents of LA County to celebrate the nation’s independence with live music on two stages featuring local LA artists, and food, culminating in a live fireworks display.

Event Details: Now in it’s second year, Grand Park is expanding the event to accommodate approximately 25,000 expected attendees, closing surrounding streets one day prior (Thursday, July 3), and reopening early the next morning (Saturday, July 5). Doors open at 1pm, entertainment begins at 4pm. Fireworks display begins at 9pm and the event commences at 9:30pm.

Grand Park is working with all relevant agencies to ensure street closures be as minimal as possible.
